



## **Marjorie R. Turnbull**

Marjorie Turnbull served as executive director of the TCC Foundation and vice president for institutional advancement from 1995 until her retirement in 2006. She was a founding board member of TCC's Institute for Nonprofit Innovation and Excellence.

As executive director, Marjorie spearheaded growth in the TCC Foundation's assets, which increased from \$250,000 to more than \$10 million. This included more than 80 endowed scholarships and more than 500 scholarships reserved for middle school students, who were first-generation college students through the state's Take Stock in Children's programs.

While at TCC Marjorie was a stalwart supporter of faculty, and upon her retirement, the Foundation Board created the Marjorie Turnbull Faculty Fellowship program. This fund was endowed in 2016.

Marjorie is a member of the President's Circle and the Signature Seat Program, which supports Theatre TCC! She has also established a fund to assist students engaged in TCC's Model United Nations program.

Marjorie is currently president of the Economic Club of Florida and a member of the institutional review board of Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare, the Tallahassee Symphony Orchestra board and the state board of the Children's Home Society. In the past Marjorie has served as president of the Challenger Center Board, as a member of the board of trustees for Florida A & M University, and on the boards of the Gadsden Arts Center and Museum and the United Way. Additionally, she is a founding director of Prime Meridian Bank.
