Fall 2020/Spring 2021

 Increased admitted nursing students from 56 to 76

Impact and Responses due to COVID-19

- Virtual clinicals Mid March to Aug 2020
- In-person clinicals resumed Aug 2020
 - All programs except Dental
- TCC's Dental Clinic will reopen March 1
 - Pre-screening and temperature checks for patients



Challenges



- ✓ Acquiring bulk PPE
- ✓ Due to exposure to COVID-19, employees unable to work in-person labs, simulations, and clinicals
- Recruiting and retaining qualified faculty and adjuncts
- ✓ Available space, due to physical distancing requirements




