Awarding of faculty emeriti status to qualified faculty.

Upon or after retirement from Tallahassee Community College (TCC), a fulltime faculty member with a minimum of 15 years of teaching service at TCC may be granted the title of "Faculty Emeritus" or "Emerita" (if female). During his/her service to the college, the faculty member shall have advanced and strengthened programs, contributed to the TCC college community as well as to the success and completion of our student body.

A nomination for Faculty Emeriti may be submitted in writing by any faculty or staff member to the Dean or to the Provost directly if the faculty member has already retired. The Dean will forward his/her recommendation to the Provost, and the Provost will submit the nomination to the President. The honor of Faculty Emeriti will be bestowed annually, and nominations accepted post-retirement.

The President shall have the discretion to recommend other faculty who do not meet minimum qualifications of this Rule for Emeriti status based on extraordinary contributions to the college.

Faculty granted emeritus status:

- shall have access to email list-serve.
- shall be listed as faculty emeriti in the catalog (if appropriate); or on TCC webpage.
- shall receive free admission to TCC fine arts performances and sporting events normally accessible with a TCC faculty identification card.
- may continue to teach classes on a *preferred* part-time faculty basis (subject to availability and current credential requirements).
- shall retain access to Lifetime Sports complex.

- shall retain library access status.
- shall be acknowledged periodically during college celebrations and other recognition events.
- shall be an honored participant of any Legacy Lecture Series.
