Course Description: This 8-hour class provides a comprehensive overview of the internal affairs/complaint handling issue. Instruction addresses techniques and strategies for handling these cases, with emphasis on legal considerations and investigative strategies, with particular emphasis on due process obligations required by Florida statutes. The class also addresses the need for comprehensive policies and practices pertaining to internal affairs, complaint handling, and administrative procedures.

Course Objectives:

- This comprehensive course will provide the attendee with a model for conducting internal affairs investigations.
- Attendees will gain the necessary knowledge and understanding of the internal affairs complaint process.
- Those attending will have an in-depth understanding of the legal guidelines necessary to function as an internal affairs investigator including cases that concern criminal violations and officer-involved shootings.
- The student will learn step-by-step the process of conducting professional, thorough, and objective administrative internal affairs investigations, as well as investigations of a criminal nature.
- The student will receive in-depth information on nationally accepted procedures surrounding the complaint process and internal affairs investigations.
